It seemed like such a short summer, but your Mission Team found several projects to work on and to complete.

- * Continued collecting 4 Cents A Meal and food for the Salem Area Food Pantry
- Raised funds to help purchase a newer and better auto for a much deserving person
- Raised funds to help with a heating system
- Collected and delivered a large selection of school supplies to local school
- Held a basket raffle and raised \$1,272 for the Lunch Learn and Play program at the Historic Salem Courthouse
- Began planning for one of our 2 fundraisers for other Mission Projects:

ANNUAL PIG ROAST: We have been planning for the annual pig roast to be held on Saturday, October 14th from 5:00—6:30 pm. Bob and Glenda Wilcox will again be cooking the pork outside on the lawn in front of the church and the smells of it cooking, drift throughout the whole area. This year the menu includes: roast pork, potato salad, baked beans, coleslaw, applesauce, corn bread, beverage and dessert. The price is \$12 for adults, \$5 for youth between the ages of 5-12 and children under 5 are free. Tickets are limited and will be sold before the event.
